AFTER 10 MONTHS, THE TREATMENT WITH FROGGYMOUTH IS COMPLETED: THE ATYPICAL SWALLOWING PATTERN HAS BEEN CORRECTED, AND THE CROSSBITE HAS STARTED TO REGRESS. DURING THE FOLLOWING 5 MONTHS, THE OCCLUSION NATURALLY CORRECTED ITSELF.
