

## CROSSBITE AND LINGUAL DYSFUNCTION

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## IN THIS CLINICAL CASE, WE OBSERVE A CROSSBITE TO THE RIGHT, A SIGN OF MAXILLARY ENDOGNATHIA.



WHEN THE MAXILLA FINALLY OVERHANGS THE MANDIBLE, WE CAN OPTIMIZE THE TREATMENT BY USING THE FROGGYMOUTH DEVICE TO STIMULATE REHABILITATION AND PROMOTE DENTAL PROPRIOCEPTION...



THE INITIALLY OBLIQUE OCCLUSION PLANE BECOMES
HORIZONTAL WHEN THE TRANSVERSE OCCLUSION NORMALIZES.
HOWEVER, IT WILL STILL BE NECESSARY TO INTERVENE,
BECAUSE THE PATIENT PRESENTS A MISALIGNMENT OF THE
DENTAL ARCHES INDICATING UNILATERAL CHEWING. THIS
PROBLEM WILL NEED TO BE HANDLED BY ANOTHER SYSTEM.
