


PATIENT WITH LYMPHATIC MALFORMATION Dr. Patrick Fellus







LYMPHATIC MALFORMATION, FORMERLY CALLED LYMPHANGIOMA, IS A BENIGN MALFORMATION OF THE LYMPHATIC VESSELS OF A HAMARTOMATOUS NATURE RESULTING FROM A SEQUESTRATION OF LYMPHATIC TISSUE WHICH HAS RETAINED ITS GROWTH POTENTIAL.





MANDIBULAR PROGNATHISM IS CAUSED BY TOO MUCH LINGUAL VOLUME CAUSING TOO MUCH ANTERIOR DYSPOSTURE.

WEARING FROGGYMOUTH ALLOWED REPOSITIONING OF THE POSTERIOR PART OF THE TONGUE WITH SLOWING OF MANDIBULAR GROWTH AND ANTERIORIZATION OF THE MIDDLE LEVEL OF THE FACE.
