


LYMPHATIC MALFORMATION AND MULTICYST IN THE OROPHARYNX Dr. Patrick Fellus







THIS PATIENT ARRIVED AT DR. FELLUS' OFFICE IN JUNE 2018 WITH A LYMPHATIC MALFORMATION AND MULTICYSTS IN THE OROPHARYNX. ACCORDING TO HIS PARENTS, HIS MOUTH BREATHING AS WELL AS HIS LINGUAL POSTURE HAD A REAL IMPACT ON HIS SOCIAL LIFE. FROM THE FIRST USE OF FROGGYMOUTH (JUNE 2018), WE NOTICE AN IMMEDIATE CHANGE IN LINGUAL POSTURE.





THE IMAGES ABOVE SHOW THE RESULTS OBTAINED IN DECEMBER OF THE SAME YEAR (LEFT) AND APRIL 2019 (RIGHT).

AFTER A FEW MONTHS OF WEAR, WE NOTICE THAT THE TONGUE HAS POSTERIORIZED, IS OFTEN INSIDE THE ORAL CAVITY AND THAT THE APEX IS LESS PROMINENT. THIS STEP ALLOWED THE HEALTHCARE TEAM AT NECKER-ENFANTS MALADES HOSPITAL TO POSTPONE AN INITIALLY PLANNED GLOSSECTOMY.
